Public Notification

The Department of Revenue and Customs hereby notifies all tourists and short-term visitors that, in pursuant to the GST refund provisions under Section 160 of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Act of Bhutan 2020 and amendments thereof, the implementation of GST refunds will officially commence with effect from February 6, 2026.

Key Compliance & Information

- **Refund Facility:** A dedicated GST refund counter is now operational at Paro International Airport to assist visitors with their claims.
- **Documentation:** Visitors must present valid tax invoices and meet the prescribed requirements as mandated under the GST Act to qualify for a refund.
